Why Does Attendance Matter?

Every school day counts in a child's academic life...

We would like to kindly remind all students, parents and guardians that school starts at 8:00 A.M., and our morning Duaa will begin few minutes after that Insha'Allah. One of the best ways of making the most of your child's educational experience as well as the blessings of group morning Duaa is to ensure they arrive to school on time Insha'Allah.

A missed school day is a lost opportunity for students to learn. In this era of increased accountability for states, districts, and schools, the connection between student attendance and learning is being studied more than ever before. As a result, education agencies are asked with increasing frequency to report attendance data in a standard manner to allow comparisons across organizations and jurisdictions.

The primary rationale for high-quality attendance data is the relationship between student attendance and student achievement. Teacher effectiveness is the strongest school-related determinant of student success, but chronic student absence reduces even the best teacher's ability to provide learning opportunities. Students who attend school regularly have been shown to achieve at higher levels than students who do not have regular attendance. This relationship between attendance and achievement may appear early in a child's school career. A recent study looking at young children found that absenteeism in kindergarten was associated with negative first grade outcomes such as greater absenteeism in subsequent years and lower achievement in reading, math, and general knowledge.



BC Muslim School is an independent school that abides by the BC Ministry of Education rules, regulations and requirements.

As all parents know, a pivotal part of the registration process is for our school to attain several legal documents from each family.

The process of obtaining and updating such documents is an essential requirement from the BC Ministry of Education. Our administrative team are responsible for collecting specific documents from you as well as ensuring they are up to date by calling and or emailing you and kindly requesting a specific document to add to your child's file. Failure to cooperate with our administrative team in providing such document will result in your child / children becoming ineligible for government funding at BC Muslim School.

Our administrative team is dedicated to all their responsibilities and to protect them, the BC Muslim School would like all students, parents and guardians to know that our school has established a Zero Tolerance Policy against all our students, faculty and staff.

Since our administrative team is the first face parents see and communicate with, we would like to take the chance to kindly remind parents that they must exercise respect and professionalism when dealing and communicating with our Administrative team.

Students Pick Up



We would like all our respected Parents and Guardians to kindly plan their day and trip ahead of time so they can pick-up their children at 3:00 P.M. If you are unable to personally pick-up your child after school, please arrange for either a sibling who must be minimum 18 years old, or a friend or family member whom you grant written authorization to pickup your child to the school if you haven't already done so. Since our legal liability to care for your children ends at 3:15 P.M, we would like to emphasize the importance of having your child picked up at 3:15 P.M the latest.



Kindly remember to pack enough food and a refillable water bottle for your child so they are nourished, hydrated and can make the most of their day at school Insha'Allah. It is important to remember that the school does not provide food for students and is only able to provide a small snack in case a child has spilled and or forgotten their food for the day.
